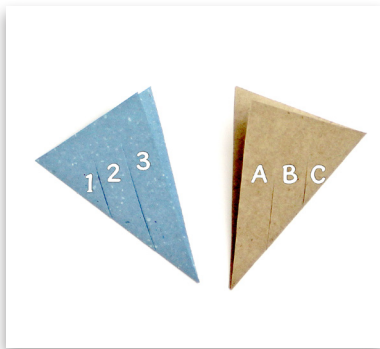




Cornet Weaving

Some of the models need to be woven together with cone weaving instead of heart weaving. They are marked with a cone at the bottom of the template page.

If the finished weaving is too loose, you can use a bit of glue or tape on the inside to keep it in place.



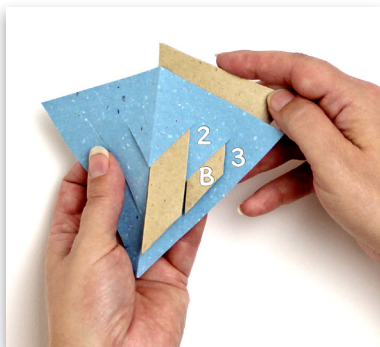
Place the two parts with the open sides facing each other.



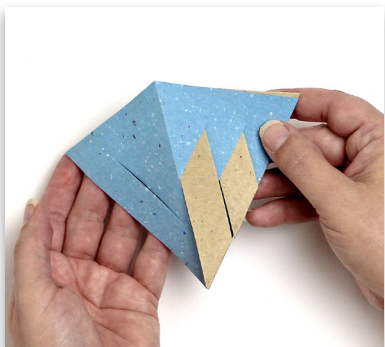
It's easier to start the weaving if the outer part is opened.



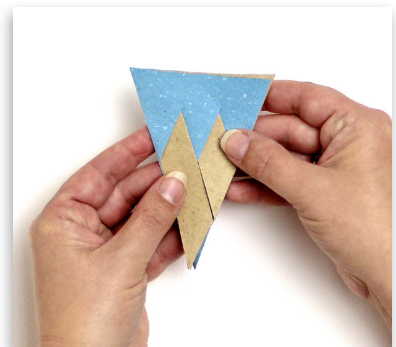
The longest inner strip A is passed through the outer part between strips 1 and 2.



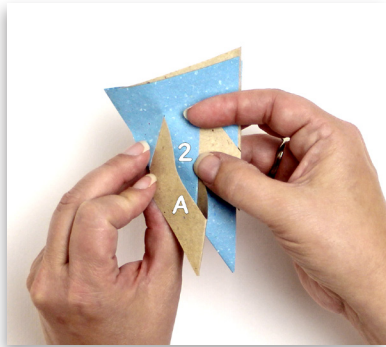
Strip B is passed through strips 2 and 3.



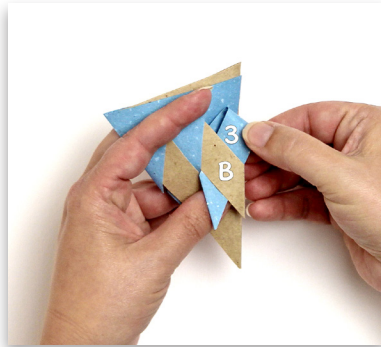
Pull the parts into place, so the inner and outer parts are sitting on top of each other.



Fold the back part into place, so the outer part is closed.



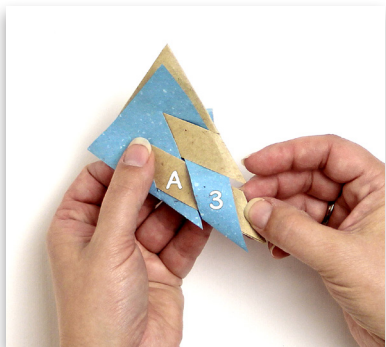
Now strip 2 must be inserted through strip A.



Now, strip 3 passes through B.



The first row is done.



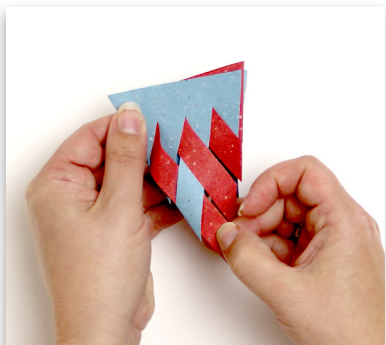
Finally, slip A through strip 3.



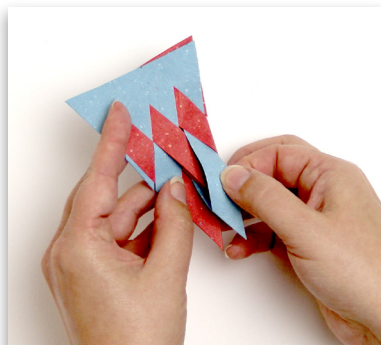
The parts may need to be pushed in place to make it just right.



Et voila, the weaving is complete. Glue between the strips if necessary.



IF YOU HAVE THREE OR MORE INCISIONS ...



... continue to weave one row at a time.



Finish, as above, by slipping the final strip into the tip at the bottom!
